

## MOHAIR VELVET IN THISTLEDOWN



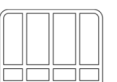

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radiance, while gentle variations in lustre and occasional flecks of darker fibre lend individuality and character. A CFA is recommended. Elegant, enduring, and quietly expressive, Thistledown embodies the timeless appeal of mohair velvet.
