

TEXTURED LINEN IN ROSEBUD



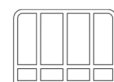

Woven from pure linen yarns of varying thickness, Rosebud is defined by the subtle interplay between coarse and fine threads, creating a surface alive with natural movement and quiet texture. The irregular weave softens the light, revealing layered tonal variations that lend each colour depth and dimension.

At 138cm wide and weighing 970 g per square metre, it offers substance without heaviness - structured enough for upholstery, yet supple enough for drapery and soft furnishings. With a Martindale of 100,000 and a discreet performance coating, it combines exceptional durability with resistance to everyday wear. This treatment



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preserves the linen's organic tactility while enhancing its practicality, ensuring it performs beautifully in busy, lived-in spaces. A delicate, muted rose with an earthy undertone, Rosebud brings a sense of warmth and intimacy. The interplay of colour and texture gives it a soft, powdery depth that feels both romantic and grounded.
